How can you become a Volunteer Driver?

Requirements:

- At least 18 years of age
- Good driving record
- Current and valid driver's license
- Criminal background and drug screen
- Liability automobile insurance coverage
- Automobile which is safe and in roadworthy condition

The benefits of Volunteer Driving:

- Reimbursed at a rate of \$.50 per traveled mile
- Personal satisfaction of helping others
- FREE Emergency Kit
- Modiveare driver training

Modivcare coordinates volunteer drivers to transport Medicaid Recipients to and from their medical appointments anywhere in Virginia. As a volunteer driver, you'll pick up riders and take them to their appointment. When their appointment is finished, you'll make sure they get home safely.
