

NEMT Rides in 2023

For Women <65 years of Age Who Utilize Medicare and Medicaid

Executive Summary

Modivcare is on a mission to create connections to care for everyone—especially for our most underserved populations. In 2023, we provided more than 240,000 rides to women under the age of 65, many of whom rely on both Medicare and Medicaid services (dual-eligible). This population experiences more social and environmental barriers that impact their overall health, such as:

- Being part of a marginalized racial and/or ethnic community
- Living in a rural region
- Earning a lower median income


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The vast majority of rides completed this past year were for dialysis appointments, which is no surprise considering the demanding nature of kidney injuries and disease. Women not only have more risk factors that pre-dispose them to chronic kidney disease (CKD), but such a disease may present additional complications if not managed, such as osteoporosis and bone loss which have an outsized impact on women's health. Maintenance of this condition is extremely challenging, demands careful attention, and requires regular reliable transportation to connect members to these vital appointments.

The second largest percentage of rides for this population was for cancer treatments, to include combined chemotherapy and radiation as well radiation alone. Predominant cancers affecting women in the United States range from colorectal, lung, cervical, and endometrial cancer to ovarian cancer. However, breast cancer continues to be the second most common cancer, right behind skin cancers. Additionally, about half of breast cancer diagnoses occur before women turn 62, and death rates continue to disproportionately affect Black women compared to any other race or ethnic group. Transportation for preventative screenings is imperative to catch cancer in its early stages and connect affected women to their care teams for necessary treatments.
